Information we collect

Contact information. We may collect your name, email, mobile number, phone number, street, city, state, pin code and country along with your company details.

Financial Data of the company. We may also collect financial information of your company to take key decisions regarding eligibility to get funding from us

Information you post. We collect information you post in a public space on our website.

Other information. If you use our website, we may collect information about your IP address and the browser you're using. We collect information in different ways.

We collect information from you passively. We may use tracking tools like Google Analytics, Google Webmaster, browser cookies and web beacons for collecting information about your usage of our website.

We get information about you from third parties. Based on preliminary information shared by you on our website, we may seek additional information regarding your company and its Directors from third parties that are under regulatory supervision and also have the authority to share information with us.

Use of your personal information

We use information to contact you: We might use the information you provide to contact you for promote our products / services and also to understand your requirements better.

We use information to improve our products and services. We might use your information to customize your experience with us.
